As is the typical general contractor role, ICI's job included supervising and coordinating the various trades necessary for the construction of a retail establishment. In the case of BP, ICI's involvement included responsibility for several vendors contracted directly to the owner.

The selection of BP general contractors is based upon stringent criteria which includes the ability to conduct and maintain the rigorous BP "Golden Rules of Safety" training in which every worker on the job must have completed a 4-hour safety program. Three ICI employees were trained, not only in the safety program, but

also in administering safety training.

According to Larry Gallagher, former HSSE Manager, "I am very pleased with the positive difference you are making in your site with regard to safety. It is obvious that you are on top of the details . . . Overall, site safety was very good. And you indicated that you have some ideas where improvement could be made . . . which is both refreshing and encouraging . . ."

This 4,200 square foot, stick-built station includes a Wild Bean Cafe and convenience store. The 60,000 square foot site has 10 dispensers and a car wash.



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
