The Aurora terminal is Illinois' busiest transfer point for Con-Way Central Express, transporting 1.5 million pounds in their 24-hour-a-day operation.

Diverting operations off-site during construction was not an option. The \$3 Million expansion, which added 54 new loading doors to the existing 94-door freight dock, was completed while maintaining CNF's continual business operations.

International Contractors, Inc. met challenges such as location of the

parking lot being designated as a flood plain, the lack of city water for a fire suppression system, permit delays, Army Corps of Engineers regulations, archeological digs and coordinating the jurisdiction of two separate counties.

The scope of work for the project including remodeling, modernizing and expanding the existing administrative and customer service office, provided extensive site improvements that included major lot re-paving, upgrades to sewer and utilities and a new entrance from Route 30.
